SAFETY FIRST, ALWAYS FIRST

While Safety First, Always First is our core value all the time, we especially celebrate March as Workplace Eye Wellness Month.

According to the American Academy of Ophthalmology, 25,000 Americans go to the emergency room every year due to workplace eye injuries. At TP Mechanical, we follow guidelines of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) to protect our employees from a wide variety of hazards, including dust, dirt, metal pieces, chemical splashes, swinging objects and radiant energy.

To keep our employees safe during their daily tasks, we provide and ensure they use personal protective equipment such as:

- **Safety spectacles:** Protective eyeglasses with safety frames constructed of metal or plastic and impact-resistant lenses.
- **Goggles:** Tight-fitting eye protection that completely covers the eyes, eye sockets and facial area immediately surrounding the eyes, and provides protection from impact, dust and splashes.
- **Welding shields:** Constructed of vulcanized fiber or fiberglass and fitted with a filtered lens, welding shields protect eyes from burns caused by infrared or intense radiant light. These shields also protect the eyes and face from flying sparks, metal spatter and slag chips produced during welding, brazing, soldering and cutting operations.
- **Face shields:** Transparent sheets of plastic extending from the eyebrows to below the chin and across the entire width of the employee's head. Some are polarized for glare protection. Face shields protect against nuisance dusts and potential splashes or sprays of hazardous liquids.


