Bill Teepe begins his own plumbing company - William J. Teepe Inc. in Cincinnati, Ohio
Jim Croson opens J.A. Croson in Columbus, Ohio
Franklin Fire, a subsidiary of J.A. Croson, is started
The company transforms into Teepe's River City Mechanical by adding HVAC to their plumbing expertise
